## Report Summary for FEBRUARY 2014

### ❖ Arrests

- ◆ February 07: (027) Prospect resident arrested on DUI charges, stopped for erratic driving
- ◆ February 13: (033) A resident of the Prospect area was stopped for erratic driving and was arrested on DUI charges.
- ◆ February 16: (034) An Indiana resident was arrested on charges of DUI, expired tags and no insurance.
- ◆ February 28: (099) A Louisville resident was stopped for speeding and was arrested on DUI charges.
