### Report Summary for MAY 2014

#### ❖ **Arrests**

- ◆ May 10: (234) DUI
- ◆ May 22: (097) Arrested for 29 incidents of burglary and criminal mischief in Prospect in May.

#### ❖ **Call Responses (including Crisis Intervention, JC3, Missing Persons,)**

- ◆ May 07: (091) Domestic dispute between father and daughter following incident at Douglass Hill Park between daughter and her boyfriend.
- ◆ May 09: (122) Subject going through trunk of a vehicle, suspicious for 29 incidents of burglary or criminal mischief in Prospect in May.
- ◆ May 24: (128) Prospect resident was stopped by a vehicle while she was out walking. Occupant identified himself as a private investigator and asked if she knew a specific person. Same resident also turned in a wallet she found while walking.

#### ❖ **Code Enforcement**

- ◆ Mailing completed to realtors and residents with new homes for sale
- ◆ Complaints:
  - Two dumpsters without permits. One was removed, one was called to renew.

#### ❖ **Felony Reports**

- ◆ May 10: (111) Resident witnessed a white male breaking her garage window and attempting to unlock the door. Subject left when confronted by resident.

#### ❖ **Misdemeanor Reports**
