## Report Summary for OCTOBER, 2014

### ❖ **Arrests**

There were no arrests in October, 2014.

### ❖ **Call Responses (including Crisis Intervention, JC3, Missing Persons,)**

- ◆ Oct 04: (220) Deer ran into road striking police vehicle.
- ◆ Oct 27: (241) Altercation at Water Works car wash.
- ◆ Oct 30: (249) Vehicle hit wall at entrance to Hunting Creek, catching fire.

### ❖ **Code Enforcement**

- ◆ Two citations issued this month. Both fees were paid on time.
  - Fallen tree left on lawn
  - Parking dumpster in roadway
- ◆ All permits in order and up to date
- ◆ Complaints and issues:
  - Dead bushes in front of a residence – Arborist report states they could rejuvenate in spring.
  - Political and real estate signs in violation of ordinance

### ❖ **Felony Reports**

- ◆ Oct 08: (222) Landscaping items removed unlawfully by contractor
- ◆ Oct 11: (226) Golf cart was unlawfully removed from a residence. A witness later saw the suspect and reported it to the police. The golf cart was recovered, damaged.
- ◆ Oct 17: (235) Possible forgery of US currency – later proven to be real currency
